

Utility Bill Charges

Your utility bill is detailed and provides the information as required by the Public Service Commission. Following are the Service Descriptions on your utility bill. Please see sample utility bill with corresponding labels.

| A | Elect-Residential | Usage is shown on the invoice along with the dates and meter readings. The residential charge per kilowatt is \$.0873. |
| B | Elect-Res Base | Monthly base charge for electricity. Residential base meter charge is \$6.50. |
| C | Power Cost Adjust | The PSC mandates that all metered rates shall be subject to periodic changes made to maintain the proper relative structure of the rates and to insure that power costs are being equitably recovered from the various rate classes. This rate is calculated by a formula the PSC provides and the rates change monthly based on the calculation. |
| D | Public Benefit Chg | State mandated program at \$1.33 per household, per month. Funds used for 2 purposes: half is for low income families and the other half is sent to Focus on Energy who in turn gives rebates to customers for energy conservation efforts. |
| E | Water | Usage is shown on the invoice along with the dates and meter readings. The residential charge for usage is \$4.40 per 1,000 gallons. |
| F | Trickle Water Cr | Used when City asks residents to run their water during the winter to avoid services freezing up. |
| G | Water-Base | Monthly base charge for water. Residential base charge for 5/8" x 3/4" meters is \$10.00. |
| H | Sewer | Usage is shown on the invoice along with the dates and meter readings (based on water meter). The residential charge per 1,000 gallons is \$3.90. |
| I | Trickle Sewer Cr | Used when City asks residents to run their water during the winter to avoid services freezing up. |
| J | Sewer-Base | Monthly base charge for sewer. Residential base charge is \$8.50. |
| K | Public Fire Protect | Based on your residential meter size of 5/8", each residence is charge \$12.15 monthly which goes to maintain the water system (hydrants used for fire protection). |
| L | Sales Tax | Wisconsin Sales Tax is mandated by the state. Residential customers do not pay sales tax November through April. |
