- Expired/Unwanted Prescription Meds
- Over-the-Counter Medications
- Medication Samples
- Pet Medications
- Liquid Medications
- Medicated Ointments
- Vitamins & Supplements

WHAT NOT TO DROP



- Needles/Lancets/Syringes
- Thermometers
- IV Bags
- Nebulizer Machines
- Diabetes Test Kits
- Oxygen Tanks
- Shampoo, lotion, etc.

HOW TO DROP

Empty pills into a plastic sealable bag

Keep liquids, ointments, powders in original container

Recycle empty pill bottles and paper boxes at home
