Medication Collection Program

Year-round at the following locations:

- Clintonville Police Department
- New London Police Department
- Weyauwega Police Department
- Waupaca County Sheriff Department

Medication Drop-box coming soon to:

- Manawa Police Department
- Marion Police Department

ACCEPTED: Prescription and over-the-counter medications, pet medications, supplements

NOT ACCEPTED: Needles, syringes, thermometers, blood pressure kits, glucose monitoring devices



NEW Guidelines



- · Empty pills into a plastic sealable bag
- Keep liquids, creams, powders in original containers
- Recycle empty pill bottles and paper boxes at home
- Discard plastic caps in the garbage

Electronics Recycling Program

Year-round at the Waupaca County PTF

TVs, Computers, Monitors, Laptops, Netbooks, Tablets, Keyboard/Mouse, Printers, Scanners, Fax Machines, USB's, VCRos, DVD Players, DVRos, Flash Drives, (() External Hard Drives, etc.

Residential Households \$0.25/lb.

Public Schools \$0.25/lb.

Commercial \$0.30/lb.

Disassembled Electronics \$0.50/lb.

Covered & Secured Load Policy

All open loads brought to the PTF must be covered (tarped) and secured. NON-COMPLIANCE FEE: \$20.



Tire Round-Up

May 1 – 14 Waupaca County PTF



Up to 4 car tires \$ 2.50 per tire (reg. \$3.00) (16+and under) \$ 5.00 w/ rim (reg. \$6.00)

17" and greater \$175 per ton (reg. \$190)

Loads of 5 or more car tires will be weighed to determine charge based on \$175 per ton

\$10.00 ea. (reg. \$15.00)

Stove, Microwave, Dishwasher, Washer, Dryer, Water Heater

\$8.00 ea. (reg. \$10.00)



Solid Waste Disposal



Waupaca County PTF

Trash, furniture, toilets, mattresses, shingles, windows, construction & demolition debris, etc.

\$72.00 per ton

\$15.00 minimum charge (up to 400 lbs.)

All open loads must be covered and secured. Payment by cash or check ONLY.













Wisconsin's Recycling Law

Requires all residents and businesses to recycle the following items:

- Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, boxboard, cardboard
- Aluminum & steel cans, glass bottles & jars, plastic bottles & containers
- Tires, appliances, waste oil, oil filters, electronics, vehicle batteries, yard waste


Dispose of your Household Hazardous Waste for less than HALF the regular cost!

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE	DISPOSAL COST
Flammable Liquids (gas, charcoal lighter, paint thinner)	\$ 0.20/lb.
*Paint (lead & oil-based only), Stain, Varnish, Shellac	\$ 0.20/lb.
Concrete Sealer, Blacktop Sealer	\$ 0.20/lb.
Halogenated Solvents (degreasers, cleaners)	\$ 0.25/lb.
Aerosols (includes aerosol pesticides)	\$ 0.30/lb.
Acids/Bases (corrosives, drain cleaners)	\$ 0.30/lb.
**Pesticides (non-aerosol), Poisons (cyanide)	\$ 0.40/lb.
Oxidizers (hypochlorite pool chemicals)	\$ 0.40/lb.
Flammable Solids (flares)	\$ 0.45/lb.
Peroxides (hardeners for fiberglass)	\$ 0.45/lb.
Mercury	\$ 0.45/lb.
Mercury Thermometers	\$ 0.25 ea.

^{*} Latex Paint will not be accepted. Once Latex Paint is dry, it can be put in the trash. Paint Hardener (\$2.50/bag) is available at the PTF, the Waupaca County Courthouse, and the Waupaca and Clintonville Area Recycling Centers. One bag will dry approximately 2/3 gallon of Latex Paint. This product is for Latex Paint only.

NOTE: Hazardous waste <u>must</u> be in a container that can be left at the PTF.
